Overview of Position	Lack of transportation is often a barrier for low-income people. If you have a good driving record, valid driver's license and insurance, you can help! You will use your own vehicle to transport Getting Ahead families to 5:00 p.m. meetings and home again at 7:30 – participants will provide own car seats.
Specific Tasks	Act as a positive role- model Perform regular safety maintenance on personal vehicle Communicate with Program Coordinator regarding facility, program, participant needs Maintain confidentiality, maintain values of dignity, empowerment and respect with all participants, children and other volunteers
Time Commitment	Commitment to 17 or 34 weeks of 2 hours each week (Tuesday and /or Thursday evenings 5:00 – 7:30) Notify Rose Williams of any absence

Skills/ Education	Enjoy being with people Work as a team member with all volunteers Strictly follow all PA vehicular and traffic safety laws. Be honest, reliable and dependable.
Experience	Experience operating motorized vehicle with a clean driving record for a minimum of two- years
Benefits to the Volunteer	Family – style meal is offered on Tuesdays (Spring group) and on Thursdays (Fall group) to all families and volunteers Experience working with diverse families
